Dear Archbishop Charles Brown, Apostolic Nuncio in Ireland

We are [Electrosensitivity Ireland, The Irish Electromagnetic Radiation Victims Network](#), a growing number of people in Ireland who are concerned about the dangers of electromagnetic radiation to our health. Our organisation comprises of people suffering with electrohypersensitivity and also parents and citizens concerned about the increasing health dangers due to the proliferation of manmade electromagnetic and wireless radiation in our society.

We are also members of The European Coordination of organizations for a regulation of Electromagnetic Field (EMF) exposure, which truly protects public health. Amongst the signatories to this European Manifesto are scientists, researchers and experts, as well as professional bodies and associations and representatives of civil society organizations (from health advocates, consumers, neighbours, environmentalists, ecologists, labour union, parents of students, people with central sensitization syndromes -electro-hypersensitivity, multiple chemical sensitivity, chronic fatigue, fibromyalgia, etc.-, brain tumour patients, concerned citizens and activists associations working in the field of electromagnetic pollution), coming from 25 countries (Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, India, Ireland, Italy, Macedonia, Netherlands, Panama, Poland, Portugal, UK, Russia, South Africa, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and USA).
